Dear Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting funding for the City of Corry's Wastewater Sewage Treatment Plant in fiscal year 2022. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Corry, located at 100 South Center Street Corry, PA 16407.

The funding would be used to replace two old generators with one new generator. Currently, the two generators are at capacity, failing repeatedly, and causing financial challenges. Due to their age these generators have become unreliable and have not properly operated during power failures. This has led to reduced performance at the plant and violations of the PA DEP Permit. The new generator system will be designed to allow a supply of stand by power for planned future upgrades at the Plant. This stop-gap generator replacement project will be done in such a way as to integrate into the future full system upgrades without waste or redundant effort, allowing for strategic reductions in costs, increases in revenue streams, and working to build partnerships to promote economic and community development objectives.
