Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Cranberry Township Route 19 Waterline Replacement in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Cranberry Township located at 2525 Rochester Road, Cranberry Township, PA 16066. The funding would be used for a waterline replacement along Route 19 in Cranberry Township. This project will complete the waterline replacement along Route 19 from Wisconsin Road to Rowan Road. Phase two will replace 2,100 linear feet of 12-inch waterline and 2,300 linear feet of 8-inch waterline. When finished a total of 7,000 linear feet of existing waterline will be replaced along the Route 19 corridor in the Township. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Route 19 waterline is at a high risk of failing due to age, amount of line breaks per segment and the number of customers affected by this line. Cranberry Township's water system provides an average of 2.5 million gallons per day and serves approximately 11,000 customers or 90% of residents. The Township currently owns, operates, and maintains approximately 195 miles of transmission and distribution lines, three storage tanks, and one pump station.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
